





The BCSWomen Lovelace Colloquium

- The BCSWomen Lovelace Colloquium is a one-day conference for women and non-binary students studying computing related subjects.
- We started in 2008 on a mission to support women studying computing into careers in IT. When we started women only made up 16% of the workforce.
- Since 2008, we have held the event 17 times, across 17 Universities and twice online.
- We have welcomed and supported nearly 2000 women and nonbinary students and provided opportunities to present their ideas, hear from role models, meet employers and find mentors.
- We can achieve all of this and deliver it in an inclusive way, providing travel support and accommodation for our attendees, because of the generous support of our sponsors and exhibitors.

We expect to have around 350 attendees with around 160 Masters and Undergraduate students presenting in the poster contests.






Where does sponsorship money go?

We run on a non-profit basis and all sponsorship goes directly to the running of the event.

Most of the sponsorship goes on student travel and accommodation: it will cost around £30K to transport the students to the event and to put them up.

The rest of the funds support normal conference expenditure like food, prizes and speaker travel.
